What do I need to do?

You will need to be able to give some time to attend meetings, read paperwork, visit school as a governor and undertake appropriate training. All governors are expected to take an active role and take on specific responsibilities related to skills they may bring to the role.

Volunteering as a school governor offers a real opportunity to use your experience and skills to further promote school improvement and to learn new skills on the way.
